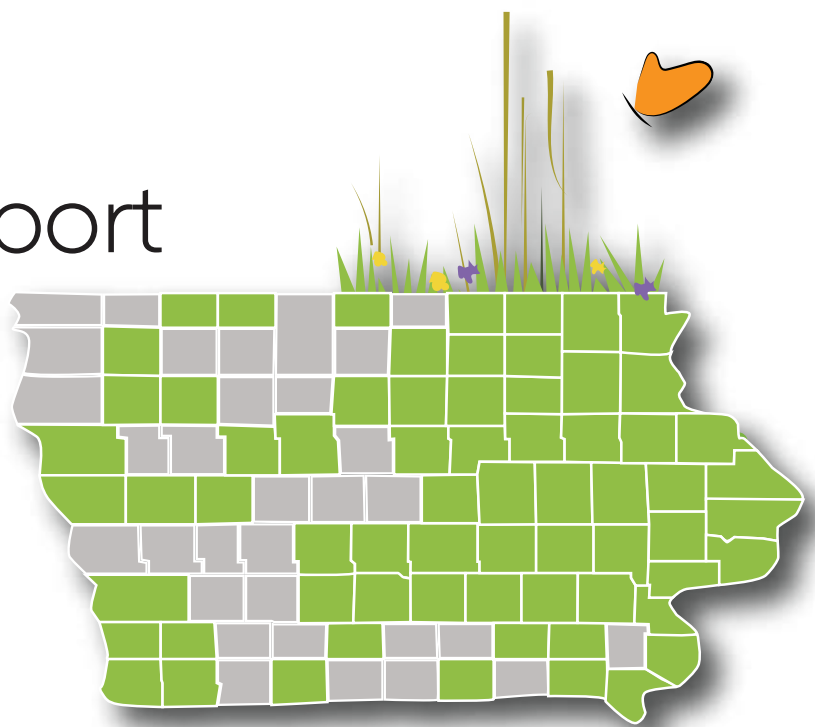


2022 Impact Report

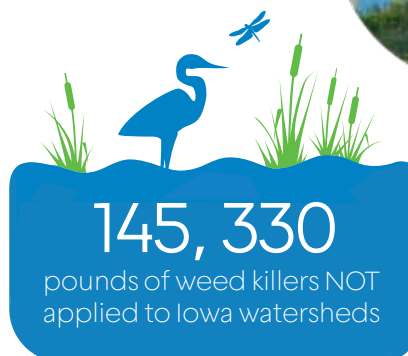
